



## COLIMA ROAD CAMINO DEL SUR TO EAST OF TIERRA LUNA TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYNCHRONIZATION PROJECT



The County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works is pleased to inform you of an upcoming Traffic Signal Synchronization Project in your neighborhood. This project will improve the movement of vehicles and decrease the amount of time motorists will be stopping at red traffic signals.

- Located within the unincorporated County areas of Hacienda Heights, Rowland Heights, and the City of Industry. Please see map on back of flyer.
- Financed with Metropolitan Transportation Authority grant and County matching funds.
- This Traffic Signal Synchronization Project includes upgrading 29 traffic signals along Colima Road from Camino Del Sur to East of Tierra Luna to keep the signals synchronized, placing vehicle detectors in the pavement to detect the presence of vehicles, and coordinating and adjusting the timing of signals between successive intersections.
- Tentatively scheduled to begin in the summer of 2016.
- Construction duration is approximately 9 months.
- Access to properties will be maintained during construction. There will be temporary lane closures as well as traffic signal outages, such as flashing red or inoperable traffic signals, occurring throughout the construction period. However, these closures and outages will be for a short duration, usually less than a day.

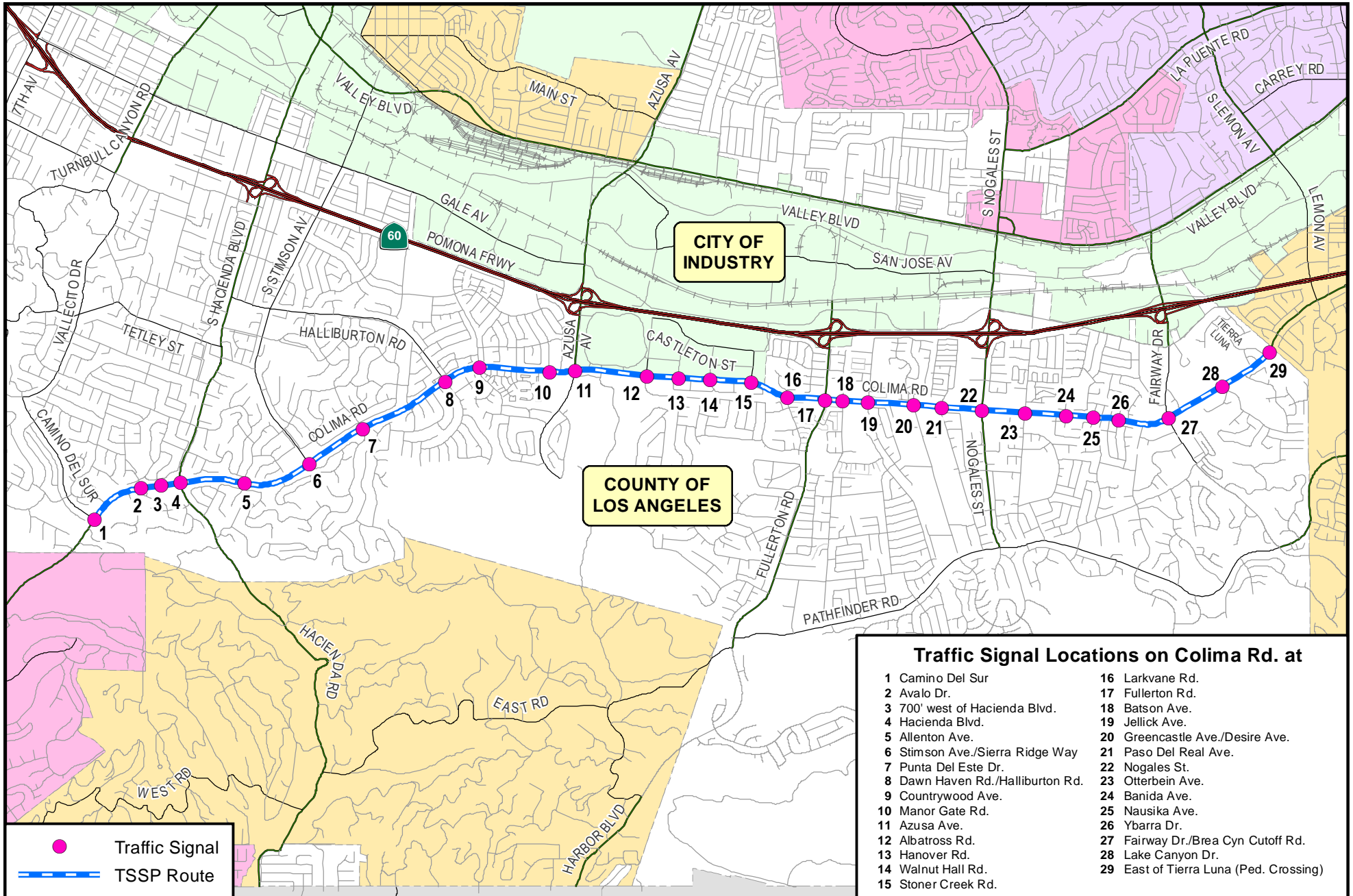
